On May 1, 2008, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license and advanced practice nurse prescriber certification. Respondent was required to complete nine (9) hours of education in ethics and boundaries and, for five (5) years, provide her nursing employers with a copy of the Order before engaging in nursing employment.
