
On September 4, 2008, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On September 8, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's request to work in a home health or agency setting and termination of the direct supervision requirement. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for the ability to work in a home health or agency setting and termination of the direct supervision requirement is hereby DENIED due to insufficient time of compliance under the terms of the Order.
