On September 4, 2008, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.


On June 9, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's request for termination of AA/NA requirements, a reduction in drug and alcohol screens, termination of direct supervision, and for the ability to work in a home health care setting. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's requests for termination of AA/NA requirements and a reduction in drug and alcohol screens are hereby GRANTED. The frequency of Respondent's drug and alcohol screens are hereby reduced to 14 per year, plus one annual hair test.
2. Respondent's requests for termination of direct supervision and the ability to work in a home health care setting are hereby DENIED. Respondent must practice nursing under the current conditions of the Order before the Board will consider amending other requirements.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
