On September 23, 2009, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's pharmacist license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On February 24, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's request for full licensure or, in the alternative, a reduction in drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to 24 screens and one hair test per year.
2. The Board further grants an increase in the number of hours Respondent may work as a pharmacist-in-charge (PIC). Respondent's PIC hours are hereby increased to a total of 24 hours per week.
3. Respondent's request for full licensure is hereby DENIED due to insufficient time of compliance under the terms of the Order.
4. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
5. This order is effective the date of its signing.
