On September 23, 2009, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's pharmacist license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On September 22, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's request for full licensure or a reduction in drug screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for reduction in drug screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent shall be tested at a frequency not less than 14 times per year and one annual hair test. Furthermore, the Board GRANTED unlimited PIC hours.
2. Respondent's request for full licensure is hereby DENIED due to insufficient time of compliance under the terms of the Order (09/23/2009). Respondent shall show complete compliance for six months before petitioning the Board.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
