

On October 20, 2011, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued an Order Granting Reinstatement of License with Limitations ("Order"), which reinstated Respondent's professional nursing license with an indefinite suspension following a previous revocation. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On January 14, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's request for the return of full, unrestricted licensure. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's professional nursing license (#138267-30) is hereby returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are hereby removed.
