On May 6, 2010, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On September 8, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens required. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens is hereby DENIED for failure to demonstrate continuous and successful compliance. Respondent must fully comply with the complete terms and conditions of the Order, including but not limited to daily check-ins and scheduled tests, before the Board will consider modifications.
