On September 2, 2010, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's practical nursing license with certain terms and conditions. Respondent was later granted a limited professional nursing license with similar requirements, pursuant to the Order Granting Limited License dated December 15, 2011.

On March 10, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's request for removal of the limitations and the return of his practical and professional nursing licenses to full, unrestricted status. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for the return of his practical (#310176-31) and professional (#184334-30) nursing licenses to full, unrestricted status is GRANTED.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credentials are hereby removed.
