On December 2, 2010, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

ORDER


1. Respondent's request is GRANTED and her professional nursing license (#161936-30) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
