On March 24, 2011, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. The suspension shall be stayed upon Respondent providing sufficient proof of compliance with Sections C and D of the Order for the most recent three (3) months.


On September 8, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's request for a stay of suspension and termination of the drug and alcohol treatment requirements. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:


ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a stay of suspension and termination of the drug and alcohol treatment requirements is hereby DENIED for failure to demonstrate continuous and successful compliance. Respondent must fully comply with the provisions of Sections C and D of the Order, including treatment requirements, to be eligible for a stay of suspension. If Respondent feels that drug and alcohol treatment is no longer needed, the Board recommends that she undergo a comprehensive drug and alcohol assessment with a treater acceptable to the Board for a current professional opinion.
