On December 1, 2011, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On March 10, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's request for access to controlled substances, termination of direct supervision, and termination of the requirement for work-setting preapproval. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for access to controlled substances, termination of direct supervision, and termination of the requirement for work-setting preapproval is DENIED due to insufficient time of compliance under the terms of the Order while working as nurse.
