On September 12, 2012, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's pharmacist license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On July 21, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:


ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to 15 per year and one annual hair test while the respondent is not working as a pharmacist. The Board delegates the decision to increase drug, alcohol and hair testing once the Respondent obtains employment as a pharmacist to the Monitoring Liaison.

2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
