On September 13, 2012, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On November 10, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens, a reduction in AA/NA meetings, and access to controlled substances. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for permission to work as a nurse with access to controlled substances is GRANTED.
2. Respondent's request for a reduction in AA/NA meetings is DENIED. Respondent must practice nursing under the modified conditions of the Order before the Board will consider amending other requirements.
3. Pursuant to the November 23, 2015 Order Granting in Part & Denying in Part, the Board hereby exercises its authority to increase drug and alcohol screens to 28 per year and one annual hair test now that Respondent has obtained nursing employment.
4. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
5. This order is effective the date of its signing.
