On November 14, 2012, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On April 20, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's request for the return of full, unrestricted licensure. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:
