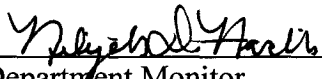
On November 15, 2012, the Wisconsin Real Estate Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's real estate broker's license with certain terms and conditions.
