On March 14, 2013, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On May 12, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's request for full, unrestricted licensure. In the event the Board does not grant full licensure, Respondent requested a reduction in drug and alcohol screens, access to controlled substances, the ability to work as a pool nurse, and a monitoring interruption during a vacation overseas. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for access to controlled substances is GRANTED.
2. Respondent's request for full licensure, and his alternative requests for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens, the ability to work as a pool nurse, and a monitoring interruption are DENIED. Respondent must practice under the current conditions of the Order before the Board will consider amending other requirements.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
