
On May 9, 2013, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On July 14, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens, approval to work as a hospital transfer/transport triage nurse under general supervision at Marshfield Clinic, and the ability to work with access to controlled substances. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to 36 urine screens per year.
2. Respondent's request for approval of the hospital transfer/transport triage nurse position at Marshfield Clinic is GRANTED.
3. Respondent's request for access to controlled substances is hereby DENIED due to insufficient time of compliance under the terms of the Order.
4. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
5. This order is effective the date of its signing.
