On July 11, 2013, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent was granted an immediate stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On February 11, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's request to be excused from the requirements of her Order, i.e. drug and alcohol testing and AA/NA meetings, while vacationing in France. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a monitoring interruption is hereby DENIED for failure to demonstrate continuous and successful compliance under the terms of the Order.
