

On October 16, 2013, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting the Respondent's medicine and surgery license. Respondent was required to comply with certain terms and conditions.

On March 16, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's request for permission to prescribe, order, dispense and administer controlled substances, schedule 4's and 5's. Based on the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:
