On December 19, 2013, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's practical nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.


On January 14, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens required. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens is hereby DENIED due to failure to demonstrate continuous and successful compliance, including missed tests and missed check-ins. Respondent must fully comply with the complete terms and conditions of the Order before the Board will consider modifications.
