
On November 13, 2014, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's nursing license with certain terms and conditions.

On December 8, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's request for the return of full licensure. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for the return of her nursing license (#127192-30) to full, unrestricted status is hereby DENIED.
2. Pursuant to paragraph 4 of the Order, the Board modifies the Order to require one year of satisfactory quarterly work reports while working in a role requiring R.N. licensure.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
