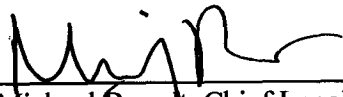
On September 8, 2014, the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services ("Department") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's clinical supervisor-in-training credential for an indefinite period. Respondent may petition for a stay of suspension upon providing proof that she has been in compliance with the Order for two years.

Respondent's petition for an initial stay of suspension has been reviewed pursuant to the Order. Based upon the information of record, which demonstrates that Respondent qualifies for a stay of suspension at this time, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. The suspension of Respondent's clinical supervisor-in-training credential (#15540-133) is hereby STAYED.
2. The stay is continuous, contingent upon Respondent's compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order.
