On September 11, 2014, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On January 14, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens and termination of the direct supervision requirement. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

### <u>ORDER</u>

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to 36 per year.

2. Respondent's request for termination of the direct supervision requirement is hereby DENIED. The Board requires further successful compliance with the terms of the Order before considering this modification.

3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
