On November 5, 2014, the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services ("Department") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") indefinitely suspending Respondent's home inspector registration. Respondent was required to submit proof of completion of 30 hours of education pursuant to the Order within 180 days. Failure to provide the required proof of completion within 180 days shall result in termination of the suspension and revocation of Respondent's registration.


Respondent has failed to submit proof that he successfully completed the education and, as a result, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. The suspension of Respondent's home inspector registration (#3-106) is hereby terminated and the registration is REVOKED.
2. This order is effective the date of its signing.
