On November 19, 2014, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's medicine and surgery with certain terms and conditions. Respondent may petition the Board for removal of the limitations upon completing no less than 10 credits of CME on the subject of colonoscopy technique, and more as deemed necessary by the medical director of the facility at which Respondent is seeking privileges.

On December 16, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for removal of the limitations and the return of his license to full, unrestricted status. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for the return of his medicine and surgery license #13376-20 to full, unrestricted status is hereby DENIED.
