On December 11, 2014, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.


On September 8, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens, a reduction in AA/NA meetings, and to count narcotics with the MD on staff. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is hereby reduced to 36 screens per year.
2. Respondent's request to count narcotics with a physician physically present in the room while the narcotics are being counted is hereby GRANTED.
3. Respondent's request for a reduction in AA/NA meeting attendance is hereby DENIED due to insufficient time of compliance under the terms of the Order.
4. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
5. This order is effective the date of its signing.
