
On February 12, 2015, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On June 9, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's requests for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens, termination of drug and alcohol treatment, and termination of the AA/NA attendance verification log. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's requests for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens, termination of drug and alcohol treatment, and termination of the AA/NA attendance verification log are hereby DENIED for failure to fully comply with all terms of the Order. Respondent must provide a treatment report and a written recommendation for the modifications from her current Treater, dated after June 1, 2016, before the Board will consider amending any requirements.
