On February 12, 2015, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On September 8, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's request for termination of drug and alcohol treatment, a reduction in AA/NA meetings, and a reduction in drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for termination of drug and alcohol treatment is hereby GRANTED.
2. Respondent's request for a reduction in AA/NA meetings and a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby DENIED due to insufficient time of compliance under the terms of the Order.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
