On February 12, 2015, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On April 14, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in AA/NA meetings, a reduction in drug and alcohol screens, and the ability to work in a setting with access to controlled substances. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is GRANTED and the frequency is reduced to 36 screens per year.
2. Respondent's requests for a reduction in AA/NA meetings and access to controlled substances are hereby DENIED due to insufficient time under the Order.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
