
On March 12, 2015, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On December 8, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's request for reduction in drug and alcohol screens, access to controlled substances, reduction in AA/NA meetings, termination of direct supervision and removal of the requirement to abstain from alcohol. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for access to controlled substances and a reduction in AA/NA meetings to one meeting per week is hereby GRANTED.
2. Respondent's request for termination of direct supervision, reduction in drug and alcohol screens and removal of the requirement to abstain from all personal use of alcohol is hereby DENIED. The reason for denial is that the Respondent needs to practice nursing under the conditions of the modified Order before the Board will consider amending other requirements.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
