On April 9, 2015, the Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions including, but not limited to, completion of an assessment with an approved provider experienced in evaluating addiction. The Order further states that Respondent's license shall be limited to address any Board concerns and assessment recommendations.

On February 11, 2016, the Board reviewed the written report regarding the results from the assessment. Based on the assessor's recommendations, the following is entered:

ORDER


- Respondent's nursing license (#109361-30) is hereby LIMITED as follows:
 - Respondent shall continue treatment as recommended by Kathryn Peterson, L.P.C. ("Treater"). Respondent shall not discontinue treatment without written support from the Treater and approval from the Board or its designee.
 - Treater shall submit quarterly reports to the Department Monitor. It is Respondent's responsibility to ensure that quarterly reports are mailed, faxed, or emailed to:
