On May 14, 2015, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions, including participation in a drug monitoring program.

On October 13, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's request for the return of full licensure or, in the alternative, a reduction in the frequency of drug screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to 12 per year and one annual hair test.
2. Respondent's request for the return of her professional nursing license (#187559-30) to full, unrestricted status is DENIED due to insufficient time of compliance under the terms of the Order.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
