On July 9, 2015, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to pay \$1,500.00 in costs of the proceeding within (120) days and complete (5) hours of education in "professional accountability and legal accountability", complete (3) hours of education in "Critical thinking", complete (5) hours of education in "documentation", complete (3) hours of education in "ethics and professionalism" and complete (4) hours of education in "disciplinary actions", within (90) days from the date of the order.

The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to pay the costs of the proceeding and to complete the education requirements. Therefore, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's license to practice nursing in the state of Wisconsin (#169831-30) is hereby **SUSPENDED**.
2. The suspension shall remain in effect until Respondent has paid the costs of the proceeding in full and has demonstrated successful completion of the education requirements of the Order.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
