On September 2, 2015, the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to complete four (4) hours of education in "Record Keeping" within 90 days and four (4) hours of education in "Risk Management" within 90 days. On December 15, 2015, Respondent's license to practice dentistry (#5302-15) was suspended for failure to complete the education as ordered.


Based upon the information of record, which includes proof that Respondent has now completed the education, the following is entered:
