On October 8, 2015, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's practical and professional nursing licenses with certain terms and conditions, including participation in a drug monitoring program.

On November 10, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's request for full licensure or, in the alternative, a reduction in the frequency of drug screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug screens is GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is hereby reduced to 14 per year and one annual hair test.
2. Respondent's request for full licensure is denied due to insufficient time of compliance under the terms of the Order.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
