On October 21, 2015, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's medicine and surgery license for an indefinite period. Respondent may petition for a stay of suspension upon showing proof of compliance with the requirements of the Final Decision and Order for three (3) consecutive months.

Respondent's petition for an initial stay of suspension has been reviewed pursuant to the Order. Based upon the information of record, which demonstrates that Respondent qualifies for a stay of suspension at this time, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. The suspension of Respondent's medicine and surgery license (#46438-20) is hereby STAYED.
2. The stay is continuous, contingent upon Respondent's compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order.
