On November 11, 2015, the Wisconsin Real Estate Appraisers Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's certified residential appraiser license. Respondent was required to complete fifteen (15) hours of education in "USPAP", complete fifteen (15) hours of education in "residential market analysis and highest and best use" and complete seven (7) hours of education in "overview of real estate appraisal principles" pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Respondent has submitted proof that he successfully completed the required education and as a result the following is entered:

1. Respondent's certified residential appraiser license (#683-9) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
