On January 12, 2016, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's pharmacist license. Respondent was required to complete eight (8) hours of education in "controlled substances" pursuant to the terms of the Order.
