On March 10, 2016, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing issued a Final Decision and Order (“Order”) requiring Respondent to complete six (6) hours of education in “medication errors” and five (5) hours of education in the topic “documentation” within 90 days. Respondent was granted a sixty (60) day extension to complete the education by August 8, 2016. On August 29, 2016, Respondent’s nursing license was suspended for failure to complete the education as ordered.

Based upon the information of record, which includes proof that Respondent has now completed the education, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. The suspension is terminated and Respondent’s nursing license (#163549-30) is hereby returned to full, unrestricted status.
