
On March 16, 2016, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board (“Board”) issued a Final Decision and Order (“Order”) limiting Respondent’s medicine and surgery license. Respondent was required to complete a preapproved course in “prescribing controlled drugs” pursuant to the terms of the Order.
