On March 16, 2016, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's medicine and surgery license. Respondent was required to complete education in "professional ethics and boundaries", "medical record keeping and documentation" and "responsible opioid prescribing", pursuant to the terms of the Order.
