On April 14, 2016, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions including, but not limited to, completion of a fitness to practice evaluation with a preapproved health care provider experienced in evaluating health care practitioners' fitness for duty. The Order further states that Respondent's license may be limited in a manner to address any concerns the Board has with the conduct set out in the Order's findings of fact and any recommendations resulting from the assessment.

On September 8, 2016, the Board reviewed and accepted the report resulting from Respondent's fitness for duty assessment. Based on the assessor's recommendations, the following is entered:

ORDER

- Respondent's nursing license (#184930-30) is further LIMITED in that he shall begin and continue psychoeducational therapy, focused on anger management, with an approved treater and shall begin and continue drug and alcohol treatment with an approved treater.
- Respondent shall comply with all treater recommendations, including frequency of sessions, and shall not discontinue anger management therapy or drug and alcohol treatment without written support from the treater and approval from the Board or its designee.
- Respondent shall ensure that both treaters submit quarterly reports to the Department Monitor regarding treatment progress and concerns.
 - 2. All other terms and conditions of the Order remain in full force and effect.
 - 3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
