The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Social Worker Section of the Wisconsin Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling, and Social Work Examining Board (Section). The Section has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Section in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Scott C. Grosskopf (dob February 15, 1974) is certified in the state of Wisconsin to practice social work, having certificate number 10129-120, first granted on January 28, 2010, and current through February 28, 2017. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 202 Long Coulee Road, Holmen, Wisconsin 54636.

2. At all times relevant to this proceeding, Respondent was employed as a social worker in La Crosse, Wisconsin.

3. On June 19, 2014, Respondent accessed and searched a case on the electronic Wisconsin Statewide Automated Child Welfare Information System (eWiSACWIS) regarding a Child Protective Services investigation of a sexual assault of Child A. eWiSACWIS is a database used by child welfare agency staff which contains confidential reports.

4. On June 20, 2014, at 4:11 p.m., Respondent texted his friend K.L. confidential information from the eWiSACWIS report.

5. The confidential information Respondent shared included the agency that interviewed Child A, the name of the doctor who was going to perform Child A's sexual assault exam, and that Child A's mother was not the person that reported the assault.

6. K.L. is licensed as an advanced practice social worker, licensed clinical social worker, clinical substance abuse counselor and an intermediate clinical supervisor.

7. K.L.'s significant other is Child A's father and the abuser.

8. On June 20, 2014, at 7:45 p.m., K.L., during a recorded jail phone call, informed her significant other of the confidential information Respondent had shared with her about the investigation.

9. Respondent was not the assigned case worker and did not have authorization to release confidential information.

10. June 1, 2015, Respondent, in an interview with union representatives, admitted to accessing the eWiSACWIS report and relaying confidential information to K.L.

11. Under the facts of this case 45 C.F.R. § 164.508(a)(1) is a federal rule which relates to the practice of social work.

12. On June 3, 2015, Respondent resigned is employment.

13. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Social Worker Section of the Wisconsin Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling and Social Work Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 457.26, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. Pursuant to 45 C.F.R. § 164.508(a)(1), except as otherwise permitted or required by this subchapter, a covered entity may not use or disclose protected health information without an authorization that is valid under this section.

3. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Scott C. Grosskopf violated 45 C.F.R. § 164.508(a)(1).

4. By violating 45 C.F.R. § 164.508(a)(1), Scott C. Grosskopf engaged in unprofessional conduct as defined by Wis. Admin. Code § MPSW 20.02(2), by violating a law of any jurisdiction, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the practice under the credential.

5. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Scott C. Grosskopf engaged in unprofessional conduct as defined by Wis. Admin. Code § MPSW 20.02(10), by revealing facts, data, information, records or communication received from a client in a professional capacity.

6. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Scott C. Grosskopf engaged in unprofessional conduct as defined by Wis. Admin. Code § MPSW 20.02(22), by gross negligence in practice in a single instance, or negligence in practice in more than one instance.

7. As a result of the above violations, Scott C. Grosskopf is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 457.26(2)(f) and (h).

ORDER

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.

2. The certificate to practice social work in the state of Wisconsin issued to Scott C. Grosskopf (certificate number 10129-120), is **SUSPENDED** for thirty (30) days from the date of this Order.

3. Respondent shall not engage in the practice of social work in the state of Wisconsin while his license to do so is suspended.

4. The certificate to practice social work issued to Scott C. Grosskopf (certificate number 10129-120) is **LIMITED** as follows:

- a. Within ninety (90) days of the date of this Order, Respondent shall successfully complete four (4) hours of education on the topic of ethics and four (4) hours of education on the topic of confidentiality pre-approved by the Section's monitoring liaison, including taking and passing any exam offered for the courses.
- b. Respondent shall submit proof of successful completion of the ordered education in the form of verification from the institution providing the education to the Department Monitor at the address stated below.
- c. None of the education completed pursuant to this requirement may be used to satisfy any continuing education requirements that have been or may be instituted by the Section or Department, and also may not be used in future attempts to upgrade a credential in Wisconsin.

- d. This limitation shall be removed from Respondent's license after satisfying the Section or its designee that Respondent has successfully completed all the ordered education.

5. Within 120 days from the date of this Order, Respondent shall pay COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$590.00.

6. Request for approval of courses, proof of successful course completion and payment of costs (made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services) shall be sent by Respondent to the Department Monitor at the address below:

7. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Section in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondent fails to timely submit payment of the costs as ordered or fails to submit proof of successful completion of the ordered education as set forth above, Respondent's certificate (no. 10129-120) may, in the discretion of the Section or its designee, be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with payment of the costs and has submitted proof of successful completion of the ordered education.

8. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.

STIPULATION

Respondent Scott C. Grosskopf and the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services stipulate as follows:

1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance. Respondent consents to the resolution of this investigation by Stipulation.

2. Respondent understands that by signing this Stipulation, Respondent voluntarily and knowingly waives the following rights:

- the right to a hearing on the allegations against Respondent, at which time the State has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence;
- the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Respondent;
- the right to call witnesses on Respondent's behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
- the right to testify on Respondent's own behalf;
- the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision;
- the right to petition for rehearing; and
- all other applicable rights afforded to Respondent under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.

3. Respondent is aware of Respondent's right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation.


4. Respondent agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Social Worker Section of the Wisconsin Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling, and Social Work Examining Board (Section). The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondent waives all rights to any appeal of the Section's order, if adopted in the form as attached.

5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Section, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall then be returned to the Division of Legal Services and Compliance for further proceedings. In the event that the Stipulation is not accepted by the Section, the parties agree not to contend that the Section has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.

6. The parties to this Stipulation agree that the attorney or other agent for the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and any member of the Section ever assigned as an advisor in this investigation may appear before the Section in open or closed session, without the presence of Respondent or Respondent's attorney, for purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that any member of the Section may have in connection with deliberations on the Stipulation. Additionally, any such advisor may vote on whether the Section should accept this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.

7. Respondent is informed that should the Section adopt this Stipulation, the Section's Final Decision and Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department procedure.


8. The Division of Legal Services and Compliance joins Respondent in recommending the Section adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
