On April 26, 2016, the Wisconsin Professional Engineer Section of the Wisconsin Examining Board of Architects, Landscape Architects, Professional Engineers, Designer and Professional Land Surveyors ("Section") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional engineer license. 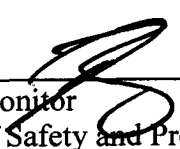
Respondent has submitted proof that he successfully completed the required education and as a result the following is entered:
