On April 27, 2016, the Wisconsin Professional Land Surveyor Section issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to complete, within one hundred twenty (120) days, twenty (20) hours of education as required by Wis. Admin. Code § A-E 10.03 and ten (10) hours in boundaries and monuments and/or the Public Land Survey System. Respondent was also ordered to make all remaining revisions requested by the Burnett County Surveyor on July 27, 2011 to the two (2) maps of survey which are the subject of the Order, and provide a copy of the revised maps to the Department and the Burnett County Surveyor within forty-five (45) days.


The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to comply with the requirements and as a result the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's professional land surveyor license (#2652-8) is hereby SUSPENDED.
2. The suspension shall remain in effect until Respondent has demonstrated successful completion of the education requirements of the Order, submitted the revised maps to the Department, and paid the costs of the proceeding.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
