On April 28, 2016, the Land Surveyor Section of the Examining Board of Architects, Landscape Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter by which the Board ordered that pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 440.22, the costs of this proceeding be assessed against the Respondent. The Section received the Affidavits of costs from the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and the Division of Hearings and Appeals. The Section considered the Affidavits of Costs on July 28, 2016, and orders as follows:

ORDER

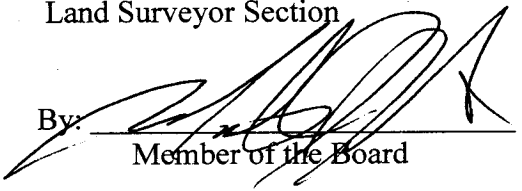
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 440.22, the costs of this proceeding in the amount of \$1,080.15 are hereby assessed against the Respondent, and shall be payable by the Respondent to the Department of Safety and Professional Services. **Failure of the Respondent to make payment on or before July 28, 2017, shall constitute a violation of the Order unless the Respondent petitions for and the Board grants a different deadline.** Under Wis. Stats. § 440.22(3), the Department of Safety and Professional Services may not restore, renew or otherwise issue any credential to the Respondent until the Respondent has made payment to the Department in the full amount assessed.
