On May 5, 2016, the Wisconsin Real Estate Appraisers Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's appraiser license. Respondent was required to complete fifteen (15) hours of education in "USPAP", complete fifteen (15) hours of education in "residential site valuation and cost approach" and complete thirty (30) hours of education in "basic appraisal principles" pursuant to the terms of the Order.
