On May 9, 2016, the Chiropractic Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter by which the Board ordered that pursuant to Wis. Stats. §440.22, the costs of this proceeding be assessed against the Respondent. The Chiropractic Examining Board received the Affidavits of Costs from the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and Division of Hearings and Appeals. The Chiropractic Examining Board considered the Affidavits of Costs on September 29, 2016 and orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to Wis. Stats. §440.22, the costs of this proceeding in the amount of \$9,121.67 are hereby assessed against the Respondent, and shall be payable by the Respondent to the Department of Safety and Professional Services. **Failure of the Respondent to make payment on or before September 29, 2017, shall constitute a violation of the Order unless the Respondent petitions for and the Board grants a different deadline.**

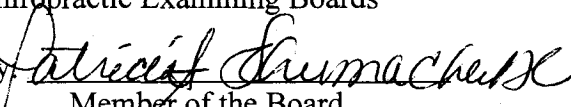
