On May 12, 2016, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's nursing license with certain terms and conditions. Pursuant to the Order, Respondent's license may be suspended if she fails to comply with the conditions and limitations of the order issued by the Iowa Board of Nursing on November 18, 2015 ("Iowa Order").


Information has been received that demonstrates Respondent has failed to comply with the terms of the Iowa Order, as evidenced by her positive drug screen on June 3, 2016 and failure to continue participation in random drug testing. Respondent is therefore in violation of the terms of the Order and, as a result, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's nursing license (#224002-30) is hereby SUSPENDED until further notice.
2. This order is effective the date of its signing.
