You are hereby notified that your request to renew your Dwelling Contractor Qualifier credential is denied, effective immediately.

You have the right to request a hearing on the denial by sending a request for hearing to the Department, addressed to Department of Safety and Professional Services, Chief Legal Counsel, P.O. Box 8368, Madison, Wisconsin 53708-8368, which must be received by the Department no later than 30 days from the date of mailing of this Notice. The date of mailing of this Notice is May 20, 2016. Any hearing on the denial will be held in accordance with the requirements set forth in Wis. Stat. ch. 227.

The denial is based on activities you engaged in at W7630 490th Ave., Ellsworth, WI 54011. In the initial case, 15 COM 033, you were in violation of Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 321.28(5), for an incompetent installation of a metal roof on Complainant's home. However, the Department was unable to take disciplinary action at that time due to your license being expired. On March 24, 2016, you applied to renew your license. The Department has made a good faith effort to contact you to discuss the events of the prior case with you. The Department attempted to contact you via phone on March 31, 2016, and April 7, 2016, and via mail on April 14, 2016, to discuss your eligibility to renew your credential and your competence in installing metal roofs. You have not reciprocated in kind.

There has been no contact from you. Due to both your prior conduct and your current lack of communication, the Department is taking this action to deny your license.

You are able to reapply. The Department requests that you respond to the Department's prior communications before reapplying, in order to discuss the events in Case No. 15 COM 033.
